Ladies 18 Hole Group – How do we grow participation on the Thursday Play Days. Ladies used to have approximately 72 players and lately only around 40.

Capital Improvement plans (Approximately \$100,000) for 2016 include a new range ball machine that will be card controlled (meaning you will not have to go into the Pro Shop to purchase range balls); the course bathrooms (outside pro shop) will be renovated; the two restrooms that boarder city streets will have keypad locks so that golfers can have access to the restrooms without general public use tying them up; the tent will have new floor and side panel improvements when it re-opens in the spring (the tent will be taken down in the next few weeks); there will be Wifi by range and 1st tees in order to facilitate golfers; the range will have new bag stands, dividers and club washers; and finally, new carts will be coming in April.

Golf course plans – there will be a concerted effort to improve tee boxes (with several total renovations), the filling of holes left by downed trees, trees will be trimmed up and the area around the tree mowed. Other maintenance will include slit seeding in bare spots and creating edges on the bunkers.

Range: Recently re-seeded, so the request is to stay off grass when hitting from the mats.
