Superintendents Corner By Jason Wolf



Summer seems to be here, but the weather has been strange... very little rain, below average and above average temps; 109 degrees on 6/8!!

Last month we completed our first mowing of the native areas. As most of you know these are large areas (90 acres) and it takes an entire month to complete the mowing. Another three weeks are needed to address detail areas like trees and knee walls. We are close to finishing these areas, I would say another week is needed to complete the task.

The crabgrass pre-emergent application was a success, very little crabgrass has surfaced in the fairways and rough. I did notice some along curbs and a couple of bunker faces that we will have to spot spray with a post-emergent to eradicate the plant. While the temps are on the "cool" side, we are continuing our battle with the clover in the rough. The Orchard is complete and the spraying continues on the Hills.

LINKSLETTER

We all know that the 100+ degree days will be back soon. With this in mind, one of the best cultural practices for greens is a method called slicing. Slicing is creating a slit in the green that is only 1 inch long and 4 inches deep. This helps with compaction, air gas exchange, root development and water infiltration. This is something that is done every two months. It's not the quickest process, but it is very beneficial.
