Superintendents Corner By Jason Wolf



A little project..

As many of you have seen, on Friday we began construction on the driving range tees. This project started a bit later than originally plan. I figured that there is only one shot at this so let's get it right. Currently the three tees have been laser leveled and a 6x300ft area has been cut, compaction gravel added and packed. Concrete will be poured into this area on Thursday and mat instillation will begin on Monday. The sod instillation will soon follow. The grass we have chosen to use is a newer hybrid bermuda called Bandera. Bandera has very aggressive lateral growth, great for divot recovery, holds color well and has a nice texture and good density. This is the same grass they are installing in Levi's Stadium! The sod will delivered overseeded with annual rye grass. The rye will take root during the winter months while the Bermuda is still dormant. Once the soil and air temperature increase the Bermuda will start to root and establish than we will be able to utilize the tee boxes. Until than its mats only. We are looking forward to finishing this project and seeing our guests and residents teeing it up!
