There are a couple of small things we still need to do like prep the outer edges for seed and level a few spots on the tees. I would say that we should be able to hit off the turf sometime in March depending on Mother Nature. It is very important that the turf is rooted and well established before it is used. I think the project turned out great!

Please help us by using the proper range educate once the grass tee is open. The sign below shows the proper divot patterns we would like you to use. The worst thing to do is to create a large "hole". Not only does this take longer to fill in, it is not an efficient use of space. I would hate to see the nice tee surface full of these "holes". Scatter your divots!


