Aerification

Green aerification is finally over! Many man hours are involved in this process, sun up to sun down. It was a great success, minus a few equipment failures. Luckily, we have two great mechanics that got us back up and going. The tine size this year was .50 with a depth of 6 inches and a 1x1 pattern.



75 tons of sand was distributed between all 38 greens. The type of sand we use is fines free kiln dried sand. This sand is cleaned and screened to remove all imperfections. The final step is a drying process. The sand is loaded into a large spinning drum that is heated to 400 degrees to remove all moisture from the sand. This sand is a bit more expensive, but we are able to fill in the aeration holes much easier creating a better putting surface.



If you look at the right photo, you can clearly see the two aeration holes filled with sand. That is our goal, to create areas for new root development and water infiltration to get through the heat of the summer.

Currently, we have a few projects taking place. Installation of brick around the ball machine down by the range. This will give us a good boarder to plant grasses and shrubs. Italian cypress trees are scheduled to be planted around the patio of the tent, along with different

types of grasses. Lastly, we have a contractor replacing the bad planks on the bridge from #14 to #15 Orchard.
