Superintendents Corner By Jason Wolf

The heat is on!

As most of you are aware, we will be pushing the 100 degree mark for the next 4 days. The heat is hard on everyone and everything, especially low mowed turf. We have a few things in our back pocket to help us get through the stressful times. One thing is the use of wetting agents on the turf. Wetting agents are substances that reduce the surface tension of water to allow it to spread drops onto a surface, increasing the spreading abilities of a liquid. Lowering the surface tension lowers the energy required to spread drops onto a film, thus weakening the cohesive properties of the liquid and strengthening its adhesive properties allowing the water to move down to the roots.



Another thing that we will be doing is opening up (aerifying) dry spots and top dressing this area with a sand product that is supposed to retain up to 12 times its weight in water and soluble nutrients. I'm interested to see what kind of response we get from this!



If you could please try to avoid all dry spots on the fairways and any worn areas in the turf from cart traffic.
