The players completed play in time that varied by as much as 45-50 minutes. Hopefully in the future we can keep the time around 4 1/4 to 4 1/2 hours. I was sent these ideas on how to accomplish this and am passing it on to our membership. Please try these ideas and it should make a difference in how much time you take to play.

- 1. Reduce the time to hit each shot by just 2 seconds.
- 2. One less practice swing, one less waggle.
- 3. When it is your turn to hit the shot, be ready to hit the shot.
- 4. You should prepare to hit your shot while others are playing.
- 5. If you begin to fall behind, putt out and go to the next tee to tee off. Don't wait for all of the players in your group to finish before heading to the next tee.

How to determine if you are behind:

- 1. If you arrive at the tee on a par three and the green is clear.
- 2. If you fail to clear the tee box on par 4 before the group in front of you clears the putting green.
- 3. If you are teeing off on a par 5 and the group in front of you has already reached the putting green.

EARLY REGISTRATION BEGAN OCTOBER 1.

The Lincoln Hills Men's Golf Club and the NCGA will begin the 2015 "Early Registration" period on October 1st. This early registration period (for returning members) will run from October 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015 and will include a \$10 dues reduction from the NCGA. By joining now your membership will run through December of 2015. As of January 1, 2015, the dues will increase by \$10. The fee for returning members will be \$83 – while the NCGA dues remain the same, our Men's Club is adding a \$2 fee for hole-in-one insurance. Any member who has a hole-in-one in a club tournament/event will receive \$250 to help with their bar bill.
