### Rules Jack Drinkard

I had a question asked about Rule 8-2 - The Line of putt on the putting green

A player may have the line of play indicated to him by anyone. But no one may be positioned by the player, on or close to the line or an extension of the line beyond the hole, while the stroke is being made.

Penalty for breach of rule 8-2:

In match play: Loss of hole

In Stroke play: Two stroke penalty.

### Grounding Your Club in a Hazard

Practice swings may be taken inside a hazard as long as you don't touch the ground, sand or water with your club. The top of the grass may be touched during a practice swing. The penalty for grounding your club is loss of the hole in match play or a 2-shot penalty in stroke play.

### **HANDICAP**

Handicap Chairman's Linksletter Report – August 2015

I am sure that most all of you know that as the Handicap Committee Chairman I am responsible for insuring that our Club's members are aware of their responsibility to maintain their handicaps in accordance with the USGA rules and to ensure that they post all scores after each round of golf they play. Since the beginning of the year, I have tried to inform you of your and my responsibilities via the Linksletter. One of the areas on which I have been spending a good deal of time at is checking you're posting when you play in the Tuesday sweeps. You may remember that my process is to randomly check the postings of 10 golfers and also check all the postings of all golfers that won money/credit for each Tuesday sweeps play. If a player was a winner and had an error, they would forfeit the credit given by the Pro Shop.

At our last Board meeting I submitted my findings for the first half of the year and I thought that you may be interested in them.

Analysis of Data

Total Number of Club members scores reviewed – 642

- Total Errors found 47 or 7.32%
  - o Players that did not Post = 29
  - o Players that posted a higher score than score card that was turned in = 18
- First three months 29 errors / 301 members checked = 9.63% errors
- Last three months 18 errors / 341 members checked = 5.28% errors
- Most common reasons for errors given by members:
  - o Confused about if or when to post
  - O Member keeps his own scorecard and posts from that scorecard without checking the card that was turned into the Pro Shop.
  - o Posted from home and just forgot to post.

- One player was confused about posting "T" scores and was doing it off and on.
- I have not applied any penalties to any members to date with the exception of the 2 NCGA index adjustments for 2 of our players.

Note that all 47 players were contacted by phone notifying them of their error and what the resolution was going to be to correct the error.

We have had some weeks where everyone that played posted and posted their scores accurately. This saves me a lot of time, so thank you for your due diligence.
