Those that might most likely will be unintentionally because when we play with our buddies everyone is always giving a helping hand. It is hard to break old habits. So if you end up playing with your buddies keep it zipped.

Therefore if you are playing in the TOC please remember that advice cannot be given or received during the stipulated round. If advice is asked for and is received it is a two stroke penalty on both players.

8—1 Advice

During a stipulated round, a player must not:

a. give advice to anyone in the competition playing on the course other than his partner, or

b. ask for advice from anyone other than his partner or either of their caddies

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULE: Match play – Loss of hole; Stroke play – Two strokes Remember "It is what you think you know is what you don't know".
