It's Time!

As you know the rules of golf will be changing effective January 1, 2019. This is the first major change since 1984. We all have six months to get acquainted with the new language and rule changes. I would like to see you in some manner start reviewing the new rules. The USGA now has the complete 'Rules of Golf Book' in pdf format on their web site. Now you will be able to see the new layout, wording and the condensing of 34 rules to 24 rules.

Go to www.usga.org and click on Playing on their home page and this will open to 2019: Golf New Rules under the Rules Heading which allows you to open the new 'Rules of Golf Book' which can be down loaded. Also if you click on Resources you will find the categories Papers and Charts.

Under Papers you will find a very good resource for understanding the new changes and why they were made. The information under Charts compares the new and the old rules along with the old and new penalties. If you review these two areas first it will help you to understand the new rule book.

Again, if we all take some time to look at the new rules between now and January 1st the transition should be smooth. I will be reviewing the new Rules of Golf Book and getting myself aquatinted so if you have any questions let me know and we will try and understand the situation together.

Coming soon will be a 2019 Rules webpage with information and links to USGA's rules changes for 2019.


