This month I want to remind you that there is only three and one-half months before the new Rules of Golf take effect on January 1, 2019.

The modernization of the rules began in committee in 2012. The committees was made up of individuals from the USGA and the R&A with the soul purpose of making the existing rules more consistent and fair and at the same time make the rules easier to understand and apply. A pdf of the new rule book can be found on the USGA web site or simply searching for the 2019 rules of golf.

Beside the new rule book a player's addition will be available which is a stream line version focusing on the rules most relevant to the individual player. Also the decision book will be replaced by the Official Guide to the Rules. This document will contain information to support committees and officials.

All three editions should be available from the USGA this month. Get a head start by reviewing the new Rules of Golf on the USGA web site. It is important that we be ready as much as we can for 2019 especially for our first tournament of the 2019 season.

Remember "It is what you think you know is what you don't know".
