HANDICAP REPORT

Happy 2020 and welcome to the new World Handicap System. As your new Handicap chairman, I am planning to run a series of short (emphasis short) messages about golf handicaps, why they are so important, and your responsibilities as a player and keeper of golfs unique system of "honor" to uphold the rules of the game we all love and hate on a regular basis. Imagine a defensive back in a football game calling a penalty on himself for interference. Yet, that is exactly what we do on a regular basis during our everyday rounds of golf.

Now, back to business. Just a short recap of the new adjusted posting rules under the new handicap system. All players use the same criteria for maximum score they can post, which is: Net double bogey. That translates to: Par + number of strokes you receive using the hole handicap rating + 2. If you receive no strokes on a hole, post max double bogey. If you receive 1 stroke on a hole, post max triple bogey. If you receive 2 strokes on a hole, post max quadruple bogey, just that simple. Remember, however, your handicap will

change on a daily basis, so you must check it every time you play and post before midnight on days you play.

I hope that helps some of you and clarifies some questions. Enjoy your golf and remember to post all your individual rounds.
