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
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Men's Golf Club of Lincoln Hills (MGCLH)

LH GOLF COURSE GENERAL MANAGER

I think we are past the consistently hot days and cooler weather is coming, and when I say cooler, more like mid 80s to low 90s. haha. We appreciate everyone's continued support and understanding when the club has been closing early on the extremely hot days.

This continues to be a reminder to all golfers, please cancel your tee times if you aren't going to be playing and even if you are booked for 4 players and only plan on having 3 or even 2. As we start to get busier





on both courses, we want to be able to maximize the available tee times for others. We had a great stretch of everyone doing better but as of late it's started to get back to how it used to be with a lot of unused tee times happening day of with players not showing up so please help everyone out and let us know if you aren't going to fill up your group especially the groups that usually book multiple tee times.

This is something that we continue to struggle with for those who have your own private golf carts. I am continuing to ask for your cooperation and please be respectful of keeping carts at least 30 yards from the greens. We still continue to see many carts parked near the greens on the course and as much as we can keep carts off those areas, the course conditions will continue to improve and we would appreciate keeping to those restrictions. The distance to keep away from the greens is 30 yards, not feet, so that equates to 90 feet. If you are using one of our club owned golf carts and need to have it set to PWD(Handicap), we will set it to be able to go up to 15 yards (45 feet) from the greens. This continues to be a challenge since we don't have the staff to continuously monitor on the course but when we do see someone too close to the greens, we will mention it to you and repeat offenders will be subject to disciplinary action if not corrected. If you see someone who is not following these guidelines, please feel free to call the golf shop and let us know so we can try to get out there and remind them to keep carts away from the greens. This will continue to keep Lincoln Hills in the great shape that it is in.

TOURNAMENT REPORT

HOW IT WORKS:

The Lincoln Hills Golf Club Pro Shop hosts a weekly "Sweeps" on Tuesday mornings.

The sweeps are stroke play with flights based on handicaps.

You can sign up as a single and meet new golfers each time.

You can also sign up as twosomes, threesomes, and foursomes.

There is 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th prize money per flight for Low Gross, Low Net, Closest to the Pin (CTTP), and Long Drive.

Your prize money is deposited in your credit account at the Pro Shop.

You can view your credit balance of winnings in the CHRONOGOLF app.

To sign up for the sweeps, send an email to (Sherrill Slotsve) sherrills31@gmail.com. Provide your GHIN number and the Tees you play from.

She will then include you on her weekly emails to sign up for the following week's sweeps.
