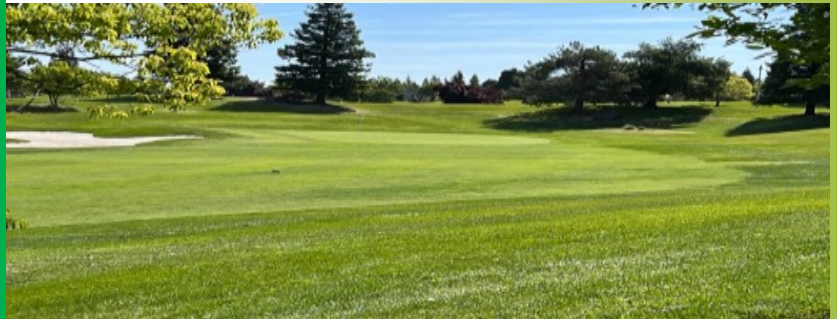

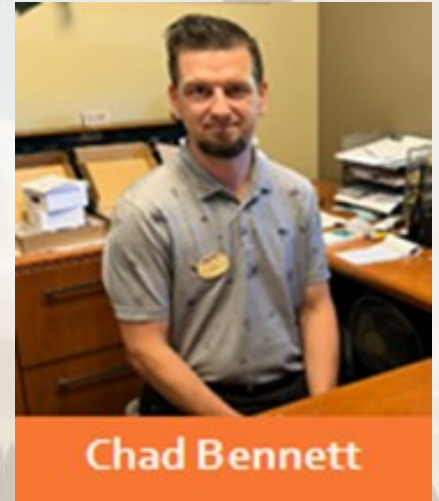
LH GOLF COURSE GENERAL MANAGER

This month's GM Message is going to be short and sweet with only a few things I want to mention and first of which is that the bridge work has started and now is full steam ahead until completion. It's not going to be a quick process but we are excited for work to be continuing on them and the first bridge to be completed will be the bridge from the tee box to the fairway on Orchard #14 and the progress is looking good. I am also excited to announce that we are going to be starting up The Skins Game at Lincoln Hills. I've had numerous members and players ask if we would do something like this and make it a little higher stakes than normal and have it be a competitive monthly event at Lincoln Hills.

Spread the word as it is open to anyone and everyone and limited each month to a field of 72. There is a Summit rate, Sierra/Resident rate and a public rate plus the Skins entry. The greens fees include \$5 from each player each month that goes into a progressive hole in one pot. While Summit Members won't pay a greens fee, they will pay the \$5 into the Hole In One Pot which is not optional.

If you sign up to play, you need to buy into either just the Net or Gross Skins game or both. Our goal is to make this a great high stakes competitive monthly event that sells out quickly.

Pairings will be random 2 days before the event and you can sign up by either emailing me or calling the golf shop.

RULES DIRECTOR

Did you know...

That you better verify what so called experts say on TV!

Recently I heard Jordan Spieth tell the crowd helping him look for a ball in tall weeds "use your feet".

If you move the ball I get to put it back without penalty." He thought if he moved it he'd be penalized.

The commentator (Phil Mickelson's old caddy Bones) agreed and said "now there's where a good knowledge of the rules helps".

What he didn't know was that there is NO penalty if the player or caddie accidentally moves a ball while searching for the ball or trying to identify it (Rule 7.2).

However, remember this grace only applies when the player takes reasonable actions and only while searching.

Walking to the search does not count.

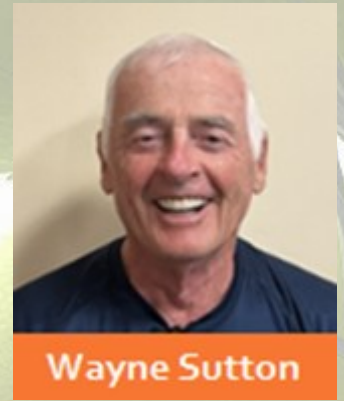

In the fairways, please fill your divot and several others. Sand for filling your bottles is available at the driving range. On the greens, please fix your ball mark and two others.

Also, a friendly reminder to keep golf carts at least 30 yards from the greens. Let's do our part to protect our golf course and keep it in good shape.

HOW IT WORKS:

The Lincoln Hills Golf Club Pro Shop hosts a weekly “Sweeps” on Tuesday mornings.

A \$3.00 contribution to the prize pool, a GHIN number, and your greens fees are all that is needed to participate.

The sweeps are stroke play with flights based on handicaps.

You can sign up as a single and meet new golfers each time.

You can also sign up as twosomes, threesomes, and foursomes.

There is 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th prize money per flight for Low Gross, Low Net, Closest to the Pin (CTTP), and Long Drive.

Your prize money is deposited in your credit account at the Pro Shop.

You can view your credit balance of winnings in the CHRONOGOLF app.

To sign up for the sweeps, send an email to (Sherrill Slotsve) sherrills31@gmail.com. Provide your GHIN number and the Tees you play from.

She will then include you on her weekly emails to sign up for the following week's sweeps.

There are no “Sweeps” on the Tuesdays when the Men's Golf Club is holding a tournament.
