Fellow MGCLH Members Rob Davies, Bruce Lyau, Sylvan Braa and yours truly participated in the 1st Annual Event in 2025 and we were not disappointed. It truly became a lifelong memory that we still talk about today. Heck, our names and hometowns were announced publicly as we approached the #1 Tee box at Pebble Beach.....just like the Pros!!

Here is your chance to experience this special event. Take a look at what's included:

- - Four Rounds of Golf: Pebble Beach Golf Links, Spyglass Hill Golf Course; Poppy Hills Golf Course , and The Hay (par 3 course).
(Two "waves" will be used so all players tee off in the premium time window each day. The "A" wave will be for team competition players, the "B" wave will be for individual and non-competitive players.)
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- - The round on The Hay will be available at the player's discretion, based on availability, from January 24-28.
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- - 4 Nights at the world-famous Inn at Spanish Bay™
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- - Both an Individual and Team Competition (Optional) – Awards will be given to the low gross and low net individuals and teams; Men, Women, Mixed Team (Stableford); awards may change based on how many divisions there are in the event
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- - Players may opt-out of the competition to just play recreational golf
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- - Your rounds will start at the 1st Tee with one of the Official Starters used in the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
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- - Official USGA and NCGA Expert Certified Rules officials will be available for Rules inquiries.
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- - Two special group functions, including food and drinks:
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- - President's Welcome Receptions & Pairings Party (Sunday, January 24)
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- - Final Day Champions Reception (Wednesday, January 27)
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- - Souvenir Gift

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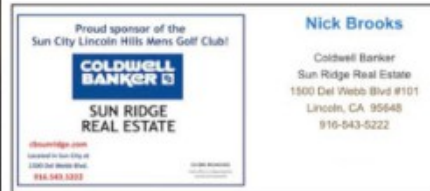
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
