YES, BIG BROTHER (the NCGA) IS WATCHING!!!

As members of the Men's Golf Club of Lincoln Hills, we are also members of the Northern California Golf Association. In fact, the NCGA is the "parent" to our Club and provides several of the benefits and perks of the golfing experience that we all enjoy. As an affiliated club of the NCGA, there are guidelines and procedures that we are required to follow to remain in good standing with the NCGA.

The NCGA compiles a lot of data throughout the year and then sends each club a "report card". They call it the "Annual Club Analytics" report. The report consists of information regarding membership trends, member head-count direction, NCGA Tournament participation, Volunteering, financial status, Officer compliance, Handicapping compliance, score posting, etc.

We are pleased to report that our "2025 Club Analytics" report has some glowing statistics. Our membership has remained relatively steady over three years: 334 members in 2024, 329 members in 2025, and 333 members in 2026 (to date). The one data point that we can improve on is "% of Members Posted Score".

The "% of Members Posted Score" statistic is very important to the overall integrity of the NCGA, USGA, and the game of golf. We are all members of the MGCLH and we all have a GHIN Number. All members know that every "legit" round MUST BE POSTED. In 2024, we had a "% of Members Posted Score" of 83%. In 2025, that number was 88%. In 2026 (thru August 20, 2026) our "% of Members Posted Score" is at 86%. These numbers are below average, and we need to find ways to increase that statistic.

Along with the latest "Annual Club Analytics" report, the NCGA has sent us a list of 47 MGCLH Members that have not posted any scores in 2026. If you are one of the 47 members listed, you can expect to receive an email and/or phone call addressing this situation. The question will be simple: "why haven't you posted a score in 2026?" And, the answer can be just as simple: "I quit playing golf", or "I only play a few holes", or "I'm injured and can't play", or "I only play for fun", or "my buddies and I don't play by the rules", etc. Once we have compiled all the answers, we can intelligently reply to the NCGA and get our percentages up. We appreciate your participation in this exercise.
